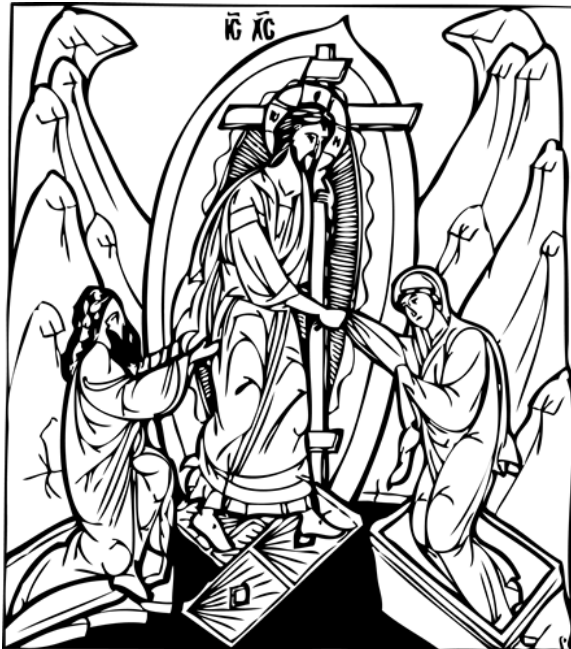

Tuesday Matins and Divine Liturgy 8:00 a.m.

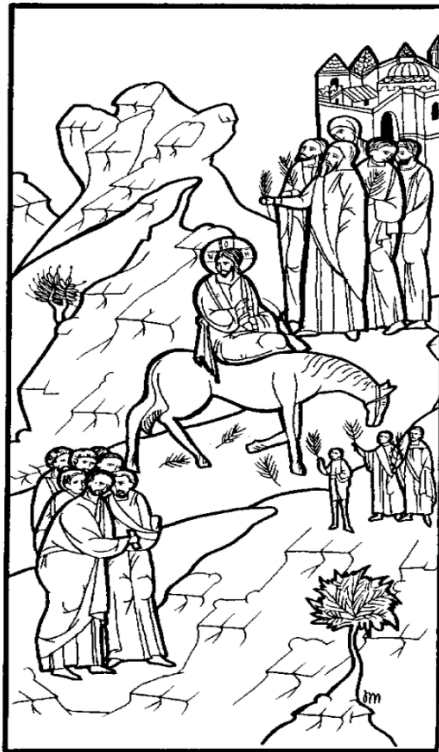
April 24th **Bright Wednesday** *Simple Feast Day*

April 14th Palm (Flowery) Sunday / Annunciation of the Theotokos

Blessing of Palms and Pussy willows will take place before Vespers with Divine Liturgy, Saturday evening at 5:00 p.m. and at the start of Divine Liturgy, Sunday morning, at 10:00 a.m. following the Resurrection Gospel.

Solemn Entrance with a Great Procession and the reading of the Matins Gospel will take place at the beginning of the 10:00 a.m. Divine Liturgy.

Willows and palms are to be held by the faithful during the Little and Great Entrance of the Liturgy and during the reading of the Gospel as a symbol of welcoming their Lord and King.

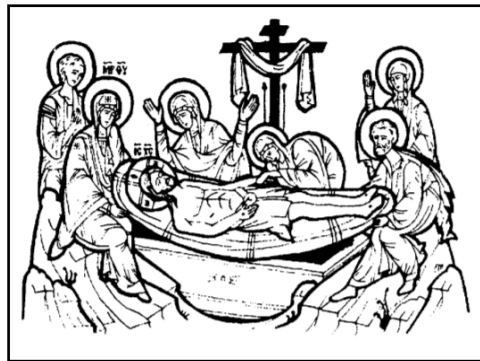
