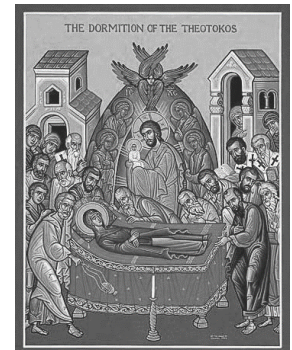

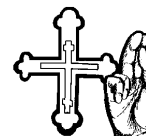
### **TWELFTH SUNDAY AFTER PENTECOST – August 28, 2022**
